## PARTNERSHIP

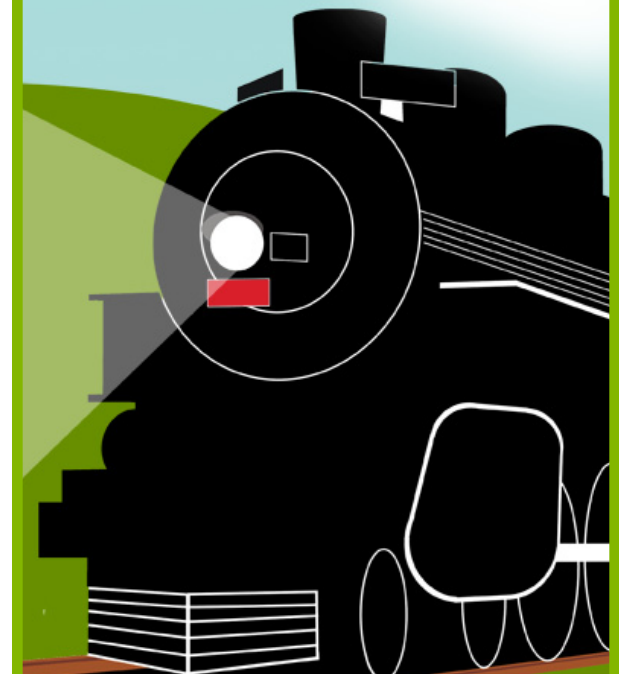
